The Colleague AI, Inc and AmplifyLearn AI Center at the University of Washington invites you to join our educator research panel, a community of educators who partner with our R&D team to design, test, and improve AI tools for teaching and learning.

Who we are

AmplifyLearn AI Center is an IES and NSF-funded National R&D Center for AI in K-12 Education. Colleague AI is a research-based educational platform, designed to support the comprehensive K-12 learning and teaching cycle. Educator insight drives our work at every stage, from the earliest feature sketches through the final launch.

What joining the panel means

Signing up adds you to our panel. It does not commit you to anything. When we run a co-design study, usability test, survey study, or research study, we send invitations to the panel members. You choose whether to participate each time, based on your schedule and your interest in the topic. Panel members can also choose to test the beta version of the Colleague AI platform before it becomes available to all educators.

How it works

You sign up once to join the panel. When a study comes up, we send you an invitation with the details. You decide whether to accept, and there is never any pressure to say yes. If you participate, you

are paid for your time at our federally audited hourly rate.

Who can join

All educators (e.g., classroom teachers, paraeducators, specialists, and admins, etc.) are welcome, regardless of your prior experience with artificial intelligence or your affiliation with our partner districts. When you decide to join a study, if your district requires additional documentation, our team will help you verify and complete it.

Why your voice matters

Every feature we build starts with a question about what teachers actually need. Your feedback tells us what works, what gets in the way, and what to build next. Panel members see their input reflected in the tools that reach classrooms nationwide.
